

One of Jawaharlal Nehru's last letter

Dehra Dun, May 24, 1963

My Dear Dr. Gopal Singh,

Your letter of the 20th May.

It is not clear to me what we can do about Tibet in the present circumstances. To have a resolution in the UN about Tibet will not mean much as China is not represented there. We are not indifferent to what has happened to Tibet. But we are unable to do anything EFFECTIVE about it.
